



## **Lesson Plan**

**Activity:** Candy Corn Bowling

**Purpose:** This activity is used for review and practice of basic operations.

**Skills Development:** addition / data usage

**Materials:** scissors / gumballs or marbles / candy corn / index card

### **Procedures:**

- Have the students fill in the circles with numbers of their choice. Depending on grade level the numbers can be whole numbers, fractions, decimals, or even integers.
- Have the students cut out the bowling alley and fold up the sides to act as bumpers.
- Have the students fold their index card in half lengthwise. This will form the ramp in which the students will roll the gumball down.
- Have the students set up their candy corn as bowling pins on the circles.
- Have the students roll their gumball down the index card towards the candy corn pins.
- For each pin knocked down the student earns the points found in the circle.
- Use the score card to keep track of points.

**Helpful Hints:** If candy is not permitted in your school you can use cheerios instead of candy corn.
